TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Registration Guidelines

1.1 All documents regarding registration – registration pack will be handed out to registered participants during the registration opening hours.

1.2 All participants are kindly requested to register in advance by completing and submitting the online Registration with the appropriate fees. All participants registering after October 8, 2020 are kindly requested to make all payments by credit card exclusively or to register on-site.

1.3 Registration will be accepted by the online registration at www.resuscitation2020.eu; its validity will be confirmed upon payment receipt by ERC.

Registration by Email is not possible.

2. Registration fee includes

Access to meeting spaces and exhibition.

After the symposium all participants have free online access to all the recorded sessions, if there are any.

3. General Data Protection Regulation

ERC may arrange for photographs, video recordings or live streaming to be taken during the event. Any subsequent photographs or recordings will remain the property of ERC and may be used for promotional purposes. Other third parties (including exhibitors) may also arrange for photographs or recordings to be taken during the event. By submitting this registration form you are agreeing to the photographing and/or filming of the proceedings.

4. Confirmation

4.1 Upon receipt of the correct registration fee, each participant will receive a confirmation of registration containing a barcode. Please bring this confirmation to the registration desk at the venue as proof of your registration and to allow for easy registration. Confirmation will be sent upon receipt of payment.

5. Payment

5.1 All fees for the symposium registration and social events should be paid in Euro (EUR), free of all banking charges – clearly stating the invoice number. Bank drafts are not accepted.

6. Responsibility

6.1 The participant acknowledges that he/she has no right to lodge damage claims against the organisers should the holding of the symposium be hindered or prevented by unexpected political or economic events or generally by force majeure, or should the non-appearance of speakers or other reasons necessitate programme changes. With registration, the participant accepts this proviso.

7. Cancellation / Refund Policy

7.1 Refund of registration fees, less 30% administrative charges, can be applied for in writing until May 15, 2020 to the Congress Secretariat. After this date no refund will be possible. Registrants may transfer their registration to a colleague at any time. For any change of name a fee of 30 Euro (EUR) will be charged.
